In the spring of 2020, the gallery moved to Langley, a popular tourist destination known for its character, charm, award-winning art galleries, performing art venues, and exceptional restaurants. Langley attracts art collectors from Seattle and the surrounding Puget Sound area and received a designation as a Washington State Creative Arts District, which will further increase the number of national and international shoppers and tourists.

The gallery strives for a diversity of mediums, including painting, photography, fiber, jewelry, wood, glass, sculpture, and pottery. Artworks carries one-of-a-kind gifts and a large variety of artist-inspired cards. As a member/artist owned corporation, all members participate in the gallery's management and operation.

Gallery Membership Benefits: Artworks Gallery encourages and assists local Whidbey Island artists in selling and promoting, their art, and provides the following services: Please note- Artworks Gallery bears no responsibility for theft or damage to artwork on display. Each artist must have insurance coverage.

- A secure gallery retail space to promote the Artists' work to the public, open 6 days a week.
- A point-of-sale tally system designed for the gallery.
- Larger than average space for artists to present their work in 2d and 3d.
- Detailed website to promote each artist, which is a bonus, especially for artists looking for additional gallery representation in Washington state or elsewhere.
- An additional outlet for retail sales via the Artworks online store.
- Social media outreach on both Instagram & Facebook, complete with professional graphics and content to promote the Artists' work.
- Traditional advertising in local Whidbey markets.
- The gallery also collects and pays all state and federal taxes on the Artists' behalf and maintains a business license.

Gallery Membership Requirements:

- Must be resident and live on Whidbey Island.
- Pay a non-refundable Joining Fee of \$135.00. (Due upon contract signing)
- Pay Gallery Dues, currently \$75.00 per month, due by the 25th of the prior month. (The first month's rent is due upon contract signing.)
- Accept and agree to a 15% commission to the gallery on all sales.
- Be available to work two days per month in the gallery.
- Attend First Saturday Art Walk and other special events as often as possible.
- Participate in quarterly member meetings via Zoom.
- Be knowledgeable and able to communicate and conduct gallery business via email.
- Serve on the Board or take on gallery responsibilities (order supplies, coordinate the art walk food and wine table) or serve on a committee. (Website, Online Store, Square Team, Publicity, Outreach, social media.)
